


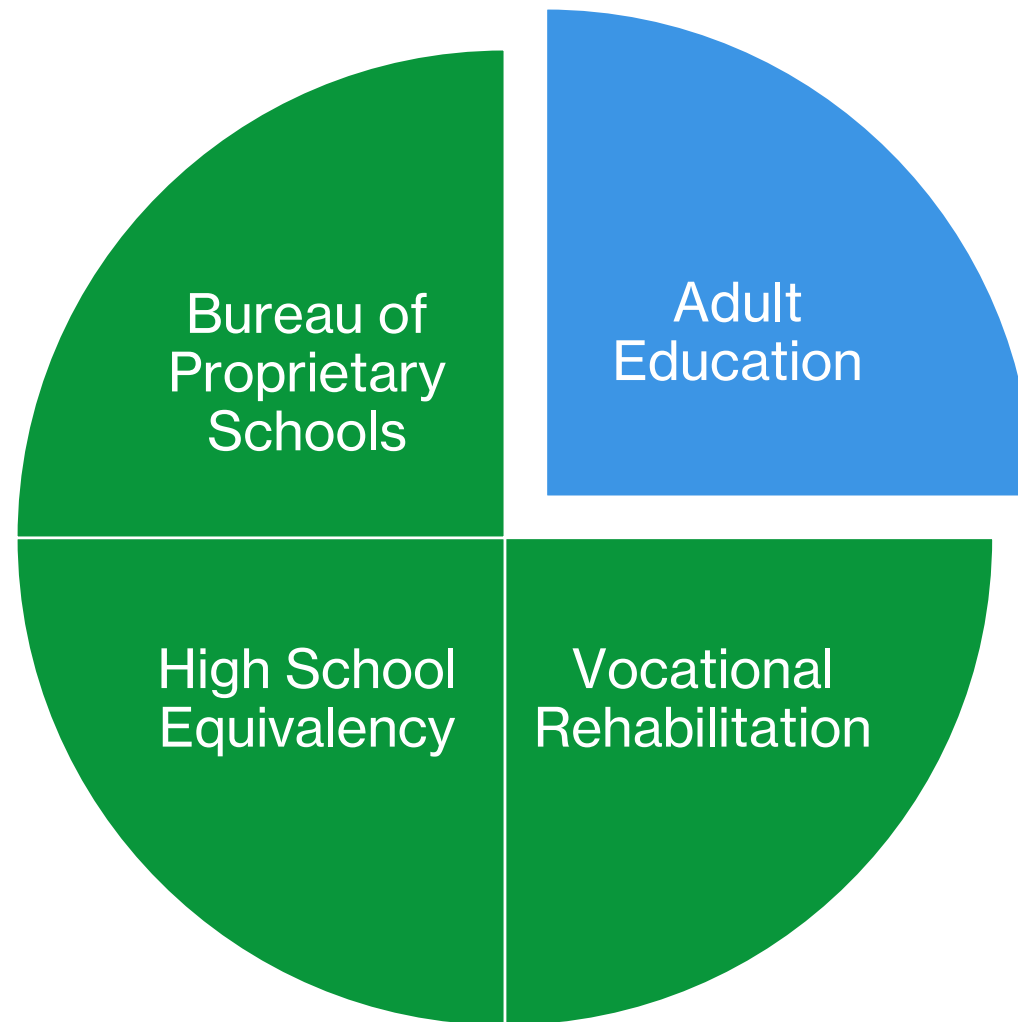

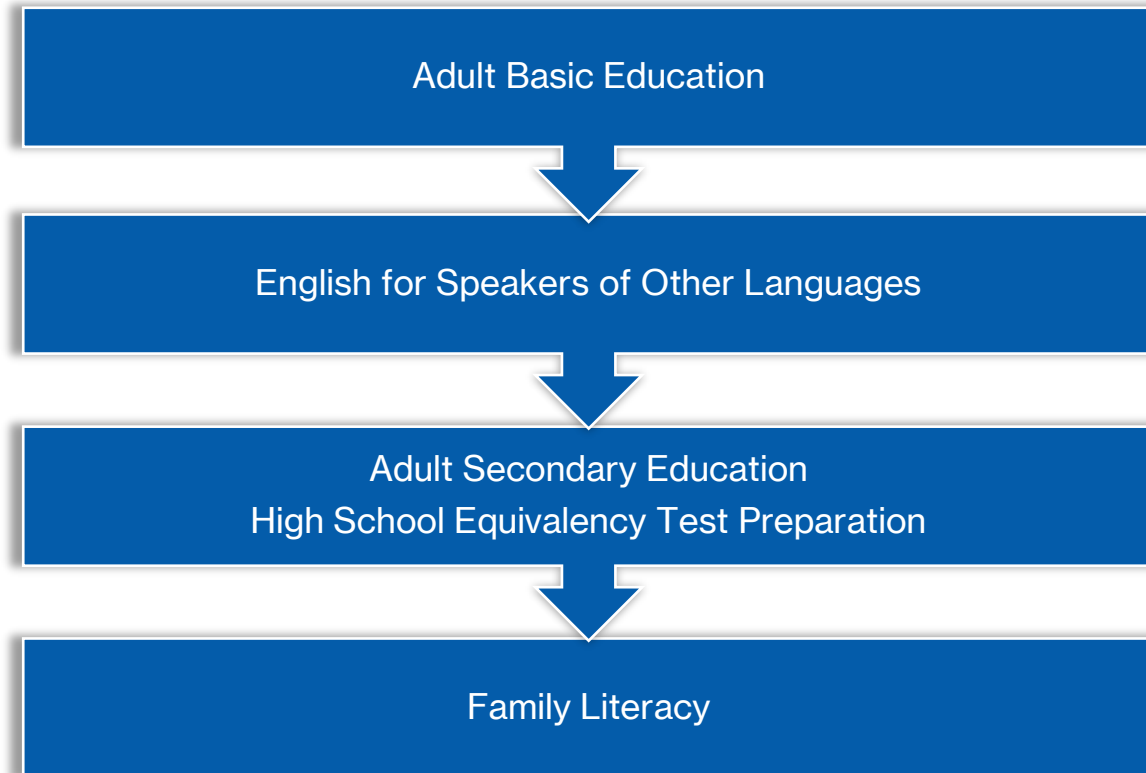

Apprenticeship Overview



Apprenticeship is the process of learning a skilled trade through a combination of on-the-job training and related classroom education.



Apprentices are full time employees who operate under the close supervision of a skilled worker on-the-job and take classroom instruction at night or on weekends.

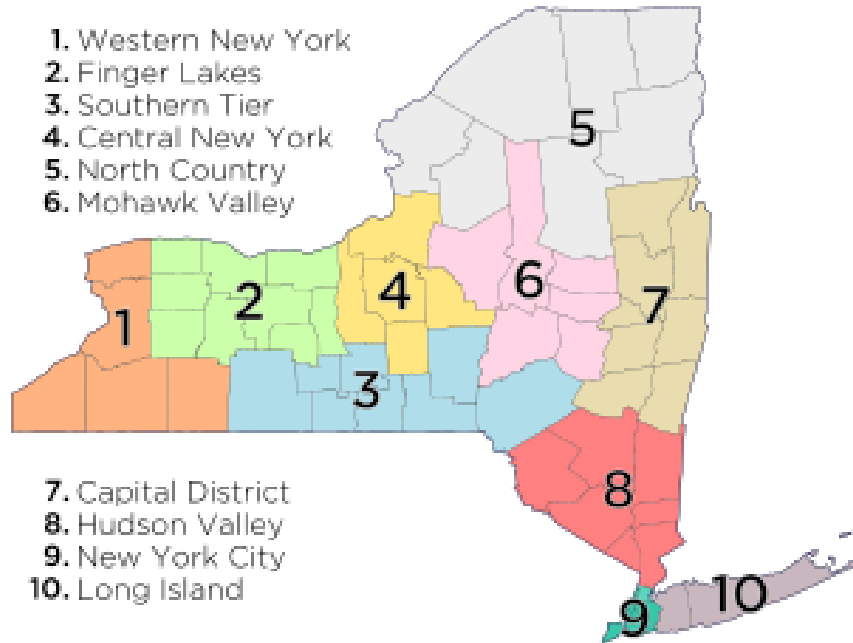


Department of Labor provides oversight of the on-the-job training.



NYSED approves the classroom instruction.

Becoming An Apprentice



- Apprenticeships vary from 1-6 years
- Must be 18 years old
 - high school diploma or equivalency diploma is often required
- Two (2) Pathways to becoming an apprentice:
 - Recruitment by an NYS registered apprenticeship program- Minimum Qualifications are created by the employer
 - Direct Entry Programs assist individuals in meeting minimum qualifications

Department of Labor

Assist

Assist businesses in becoming a registered apprenticeship

Educate

Educate businesses about the Apprenticeship Tax Credit

Post

Post information about apprenticeship opportunities on the DOL website

Conduct

Conduct monitoring to provide technical assistance and ensure that businesses comply with Federal and State apprenticeship laws and regulations

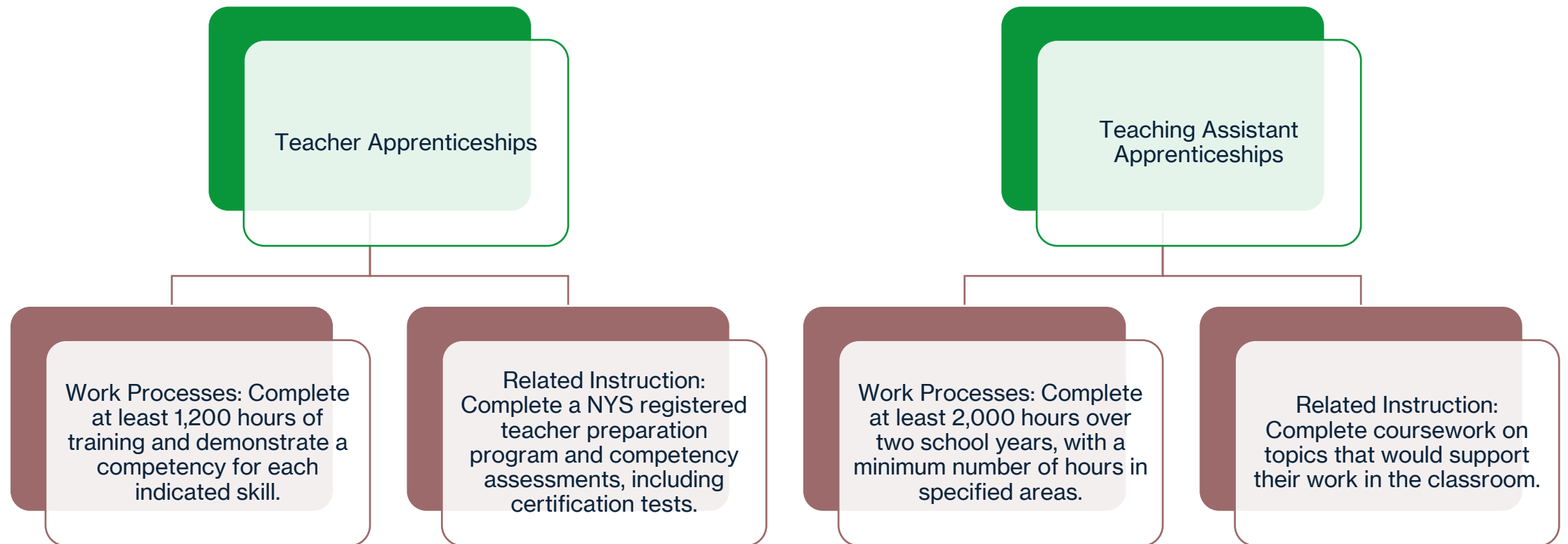
