





SUMMARY

**Issue for Decision**

Should the Regents register the public elementary, intermediate and high schools listed in the attached table?

**Reason(s) for Consideration**

**Required by State Regulations.** Required by Commissioner's Regulations Section 100.18.

**Proposed Handling**

The question will come before the Regents for action at its July 2012 meeting.

**Procedural History**

Beginning in July 2003, the Regents have annually approved the registration of new public schools at their July meeting.

**Background Information**

Commissioner's Regulations require that districts that seek to register a public elementary, intermediate or high school must submit a petition to the Board of Regents seeking registration of such schools.

The schools listed on the attached table are being recommended by the Commissioner for registration, based upon school districts submitting petitions and supporting materials for these schools certifying the districts' commitment to operate

these schools in compliance with applicable statutes, rules, and regulations relating to public schools and in compliance with applicable building codes.

Attachment A provides a listing of those schools for which districts have petitioned for registration effective with the beginning of the 2012-2013 school year.

After the registration of these schools, pursuant to section 100.18 of Commissioner's Regulations the accountability status of the newly registered schools will be determined, by the Commissioner. A school district that seeks to register a new public elementary, intermediate or high school must submit an addendum to the petition that provides such information as:

- Student admission criteria, including those pertaining to English language learners and students with disabilities, and zoning patterns;
- Staffing (administration and instructional);
- Curricula; and,
- Facilities

This information is used to determine whether a school should open with an accountability status of "Good Standing" or should carry over the accountability status of a school from which it split, into which it merged, or for which it is the successor.

### **Recommendation**

Voted: That the schools listed on the attached table be registered.

### **Timetable for Implementation**

Schools listed in Attachment A will be registered effective with the beginning of the 2012-2013 school year.

\*In lieu of a resolution passed by the New York City Board of Education (typically referred to as the Panel on Educational Policy), the New York City Department of Education submitted a declaration of emergency action by the Chancellor to create a school to address overcrowding in kindergarten in CSD 24. Operation of this new school beyond the initial six month emergency period is contingent upon compliance with Education Law section 2590-h(2-a). If the NYC Panel for Educational Policy does not approve the resolution or the emergency action is set-aside by the Commissioner or the courts, the registration will be considered null and void.
